**APPOINTMENT OF JUNIOR RESIDENTS
THROUGH**

WALK-IN-INTERVIEW

**FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS/SIX MONTHS (AS THE CASE MAY BE)
AT A TIME ON TENURE BASIS AGAINST VACANT POSTS OF
SR.RESIDENTS IN IGMC, SHIMLA-171001.**

Applications for the posts of Junior Residents are invited from the desirous candidates on the prescribed application form at Annexure "A" for a term of three years/six months (as the case may be) at a time on tenure basis through Walk-in-Interview who fulfils the requisite qualifications and other terms & conditions laid-down hereunder. The speciality-wise vacancy is detailed in "Annexure-B". The last date by which the application complete in all respects should reach in the office of Principal, IGMC, Shimla-1 is **on or before 19.2.2018.**

Venue for Walk-in-Interview : Committee Room, IGMC, Shimla-1

Date & Time: On 19.2.2018 at 3.00 PM.

Eligibility & Essential Qualifications:

Direct candidates and those regularly appointed GDOs who possess a M.B.B.S. degree as recognized by MCI. **These positions will not be offered to any Post graduate doctor.**

PAY & ALLOWANCES:

GDOs appointed on regular basis, on their selection as Junior Resident will continue to draw pay and allowances/increments as admissible to them in their pay-scale. MBBS doctors appointed under the direct category will get Rs.36,000/- (Rupees thirty six thousand only) fixed per month on their selection as Junior Residents.

AGE LIMIT: 45 Years and below:

i) Provided that upper age limit will not be applicable to the candidate already in service of the government including those who have been appointed on adhoc or on contract basis by the Govt.

ii) Provided further that upper age limit is relaxable for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Other categories of persons to the extent permissible under the general or special order(s) of the Himachal Pradesh Government.

iii) Age limit for direct recruitment will be reckoned on the first day of the year in which the post(s) are advertised for inviting application.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

i) The selection of the Junior Resident will be made strictly on the basis of merit of candidates in the MBBS examination and by adopting the following selection criteria.

ii) **First preference would be given to the Direct MBBS doctors who are not in the employment of the Government of H.P.** The selection will be made purely on the basis of merit of candidate in MBBS examinations.

iii) Second preference would be given (**subject to maximum of 15 seats in Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla at any point of time**) to GDO's whose spouse are working, in order of preference, as Sr.Resident or Faculty in the respective Medical College or in the State/ Central Govt. (including semi-government/ autonomous bodies fully or partially funded by the Govt.). In case there is more than one applicant for a particular position, the applicant having higher score in MBBS examination will be selected.

iv) Junior Resident will be appointed for a term of six months at a time and will not be extendable beyond one year. However, in case the spouse working in the concerned Medical College the period of Residency (both direct & GDO) will be extendable upto three years subject to the condition that they will not be entitled for 2nd tenure.

v) In Super-speciality Departments only, Junior Residents will be appointed for a period of three years instead of six months.

REMOVAL/RESIGNATION FROM POSTS OF JUNIOR RESIDENTS:

Once appointed, the incumbent can be removed from the post any time after joining in case of misconduct, misbehaviour, acts of commission/omission, unbecoming of a public servant. The HOD will make a formal request in writing to the Principal of the Medical College for removing the delinquent appointee. The Principal of the Medical College will take final decision in the matter after hearing both the parties. It will be necessary to give due opportunity to the concerned Sr.Resident to explain his/her position. Any Jr.Resident shall have to give one month's notice or salary in lieu thereof to resign and the concerned Principal accept the same.

NECESSITY OF NOC:

No application of in-service candidates (GDOs/adhoc/contract/RKS) will be entertained by the Principal unless the "No objection Certificate" is issued by the Principal Secretary (Health) to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-171002/Director Health Services, HP Shimla, in the case of regular GDOs and adhoc/contract appointee doctors by the state Govt.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Candidates will be allowed to apply in one speciality only.
2. Speciality once chosen will be final and if selected, the candidates will not be permitted to change speciality at any stage during this period/tenure except as provide under rules.
3. The offer is subject to the condition that as & when the Sr.Resident will join there, the Junior Resident will have to vacate the post after having got relieved from his/her assignment on completion of three years/six months (as the case may be).
4. Incomplete or wrongly addressed applications shall not be considered at all and shall be rejected out-rightly. The Principal will make no further correspondence with the candidate in the matter.
5. The in-service GDOs/candidates are required to route their applications through proper channel for obtaining NOC from the competent authority as the NOC will have to be produced at the time while appearing in the walk-in-interview on 19.2.2018 at 3.00 PM.
6. The candidate should enclose the certified copies of the following certificates/documents alongwith application form.:-
 - i) Certificate of Matriculation or its equivalent examination (for verification of age).
 - ii) Detail marks certificate of Professional examination (MBBS Degree).
 - iii) Character certificate from the employer /Head of the institution.
 - iv) Registration Certificate from Medical Council.
 - v) Attempt certificate in respect of MBBS.

Rest of the terms & conditions will apply the same as contained in the policy issued by the Government vide Notification No:HFV-B(A)2-4/2007- dated 4.1.2012 and corrigendum dated 20.6.2012, Notification No:HFV-B(A)-2-4/2007-I- dated 4.6.2013 and No:HFV-B(B)1-2/2007-loose-1 dated 30.12.2015 and No:HFV-B(B)15-23/2015- dated 21.1.2016 respectively issued by the Govt. to this effect from time to time.
